## What is the iSchool Inclusion Institute (i3)?

i3 is an undergraduate research program that prepares students from underrepresented populations for graduate study in the information sciences

Introductory Institute (Four Weeks, June 2013)	<ul> <li>Cohort of 20 students</li> <li>Special-topics workshops, guest speakers, and networking</li> <li>Professional development sessions and mentoring from experts in academia and industry; field trips, tours, and social events</li> </ul>
Team Research Project	<ul> <li>After the four-week institute, students pursue a year-long team project</li> <li>Teams use social networking tools and collaborative technology</li> <li>Projects are determined by the team and emphasize creativity and innovation</li> </ul>
Concluding Institute (Two Weeks, June 2014)	<ul> <li>Design a research poster and present team project</li> <li>Consult with iSchool mentors and recruiters from across the country</li> <li>Receive practical advice on financial aid and scholarships</li> </ul>
